

TROJAN WOMEN (ΤΡΩΑΔΕΣ)

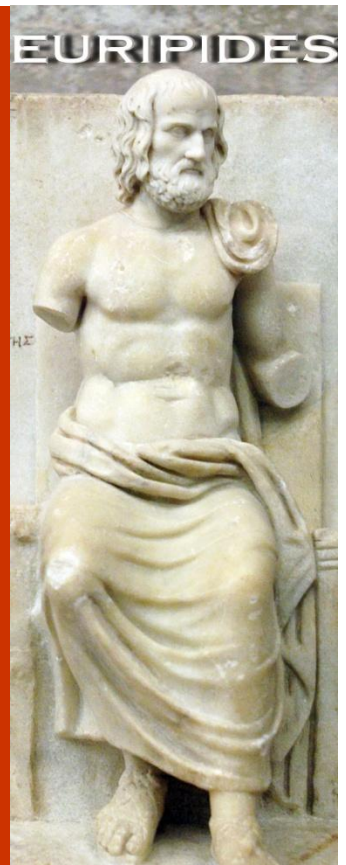

Directions to ATKINSON HALL AUDITORIUM: From I-5 or Rte 805, exit at La Jolla Village Dr. and go West. Turn Right on Villa La Jolla Dr. (first right after exiting I-5) and then turn Right on Gilman Dr. Turn Left on Voight Dr., and stay on Voight Dr. by turning Right at the second STOP sign. A few feet after the next STOP sign, there is on the Left side a large, grey building with narrow windows, ATKINSON HALL. Continue around the curve to the end of the building and turn into Parking Lot 520 to your Right for free parking.
